Carpport and Drop off

Carpport service will be postponed this summer due to the heat and will resume in the Fall.

Please walk your children to the toddler door as normal and they will go in the classroom. If you are primary , please walk them to Mrs. Smitas patio and say your good-byes and let them walk into

the classroom.

The gates will be locked promptly at **8:30**. We will open the gate at **8:45am** for late students and again at **9am**. Students who arrive at school after 9:15 must have a doctors note or be discussed previously with the office staff or your child’s teacher.
